

Prospectus- Eligibility for All Shows CCAL
Do not alter.....Revised 4-2010

Eligibility for all shows is open to current members of the CCAL.

The November and March Shows are open to all Art Council of Southwest Council Florida Members.

Media : Oil, watercolor, acrylic, mixed media, sculpture, collage, pen and ink, pencil, pastel and photography are accepted mediums. No digitally altered photography will be accepted.

Requirements : Art must have been completed within the last two (2) years. Works, which have received an award higher than Honorable Mention, in any Southwest Council or CCAL Art shows, are not eligible. All work must be original, not a copy of another artist's work or from a magazine, book or photograph not originally taken by the artist or used without permission from the photographer. Any copies will be removed. Art must not be a giclee, or print reproduction. Art must be the creation of the artist without physical assistance from another artist or instructor. Be prepared to show references if asked.

Works must be thoroughly dry and suitably framed or gallery wrapped with painted, staple free edges that are not white. They must have a wire in the back for hanging that does not exceed higher than 3 inches from the top of the painting, with ends taped for protection. All works, with the exception of works on canvas, must have glass or plexi. Works received without glass or plexi, will be rejected. Framed works larger than (24x30) must be framed using plexi-glass/acrylic, not regular glass. Works must not exceed 48 x 48 including framing. Sculptures should not exceed 40 pounds in weight and have their own pedestal.

Commission: Paintings sold during the show must remain in the gallery until the end of the show. A commission of 30% of all sales will be donated to CCAL, remaining monies to be paid to the artist at the end of the show. All sales are handled thru the CCAL Gift Shop. Artist assumes the responsibility for paying the sales tax.

Award winners must be present or represented at the opening or forfeit their cash award to the CCAL Scholarship Fund. Award recipients will be notified by telephone. The number of entries and judging costs will determine prizes. Artists will be notified of declined works and will be required to pick up their art immediately during regular office hours. All entries are to remain in the gallery until the show is officially closed.

Fees: The entry fee for all shows is \$20.00 for paid members and \$30.00 for non-members for 3 pieces of entered work.

CCAL members are encouraged to support their league by entering their works and being present and contributing to the reception. Member exhibitors are required to be docents at least one day while the show is open.
