Open to all Cape Coral Art League Members and those new emerging or re-emerging artists who would like to join our group of talented artists!

Media: Original 2D and 3D works of Fine Art displaying a variety of media to include painting, mixed media, sculpture, and pottery. No digitally altered photography, no crafts. (If you have a question concerning your media call the show chair.)

Restrictions: To display in our gallery: EVERY art item must be the sole creation conceived from an ORIGINAL idea by the artist and completed within the past 2 (two) years. Artwork cannot have been exhibited previously in our gallery or won an award of more than \$100. Size may not exceed 72 inches in either direction. No glass, plexiglass only for framed artwork. Also not acceptable: art created in class or under the assistance of an instructor; use of an unauthorized photograph or copyrighted material; assembled pieces not made by the artist; and giclees, limited editions, or reproductions. All 2-D work must be acceptably framed with picture wire no higher than 3" below the top of the frame and/or have painted edges with no visible staples. (Please tape wire ends.) Artists of 3-D art, it would be helpful if you could provide pedestals for your work. Gallery receiving personnel have the right to reject any unsuitable or objectionable pieces.

Fees: \$15 for up to two entries. To become a member, bring your artwork to receiving on

October 2nd. Membership is \$35 + \$15 entry fee = \$50. Your membership will be good for one year. Renew in January 2008. Make checks payable to the Cape Coral Art League.

Commission: 20% of all sales to be made to CCAL by the selling artist. Art sold during the show must remain in the gallery until the official show removal time.

Receiving: Monday, October 2nd, 2006 noon to 2 p.m.

Awards: Prizes will be determined by the amount received and donated by local contributors.

Judge: To be announced

Removal: October 29th; 3:30-4pm. Work not picked up will be charged \$1 per day storage

fee.
