### **01-06-25 Water Wonderland**

Water needs to be incorporated into the artwork from a mere drop to an ocean to any way we can express this vital element in our art. This theme is intended to be inclusive and open to artists' interpretation.

### **02-03-25 Wild About Wildlife (Open to ACSWF)**

What do you think when you hear the word "wildlife"? If you are a nature lover, here's an opportunity to express your feelings about the nature world in your art. If you think "party animal", have fun with this wildlife theme. This theme is meant to be inclusive and open to artist interpretation.

### **03-03-25 Simply Red (Open to ACSWF)**

Red has many different symbolic meanings, from anger to danger, and for love and courage as well. It has strong emotional impact, both positive and negative. Explore this primary color in your artwork for this themed show. This theme is meant to be inclusive and open to artistic interpretation.
