

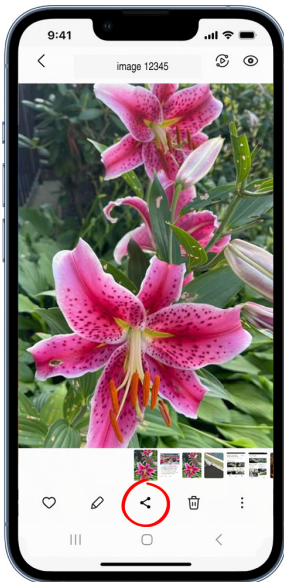

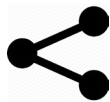

## HOW TO SUBMIT PHOTOS

Follow the directions below to select the photo of the artwork and to open your email program.



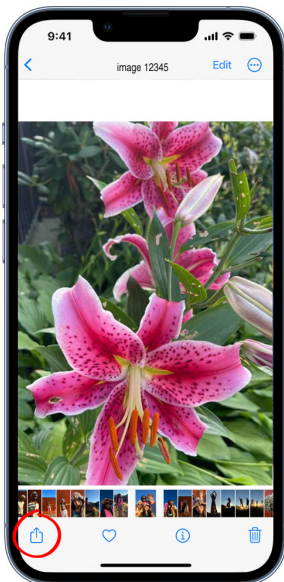
On **Android**, open the picture in the Gallery or Photos app, tap the "Share" icon and select your email app icon.

On **iPhone**, open the photo you want to share in the Photos app, tap the "Share" icon, then tap your email app icon.

## WHAT YOUR EMAIL SHOULD INCLUDE

1. A quality digital photo between 500KB and 1.2MB in size in jpeg format. If possible, please crop your photo to show only the artwork without a frame or background. *Framed artwork with glass is best photographed prior to framing as reflection from the glass will show on the photo otherwise.*
2. The title of the artwork
3. The artwork medium
4. The size of the artwork WITHOUT a frame
5. Whether piece is available framed or unframed
6. The price for the piece
7. Your name

## PLEASE NOTE:

Artwork received by the Opening Reception will be posted to the CCAL website by the following Monday and available for sale for the remainder of the show.

Gallery commission is 40% and will be deducted from any sale made through the Gallery Show Online Store.

Artwork sold online may be picked up from the Art League at the show's conclusion, or by agreement prior to the show conclusion, if necessary.

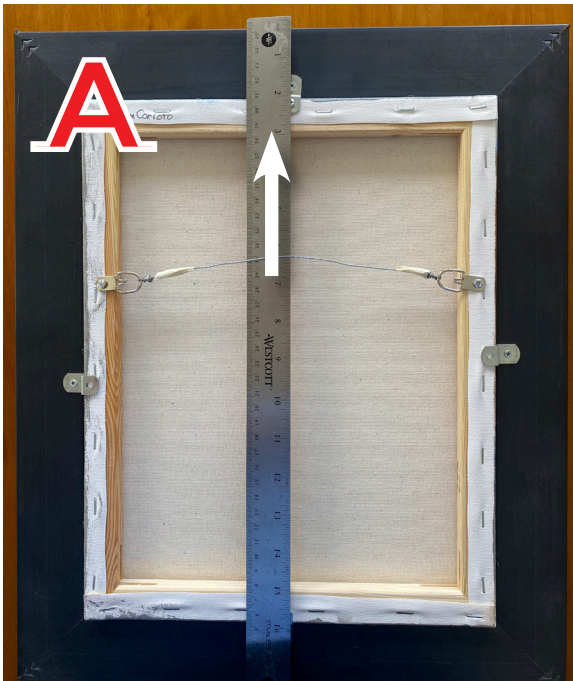
A check will be issued to the artist within two weeks of show conclusion.

Online purchases requiring shipment will be at the responsibility of the artist.

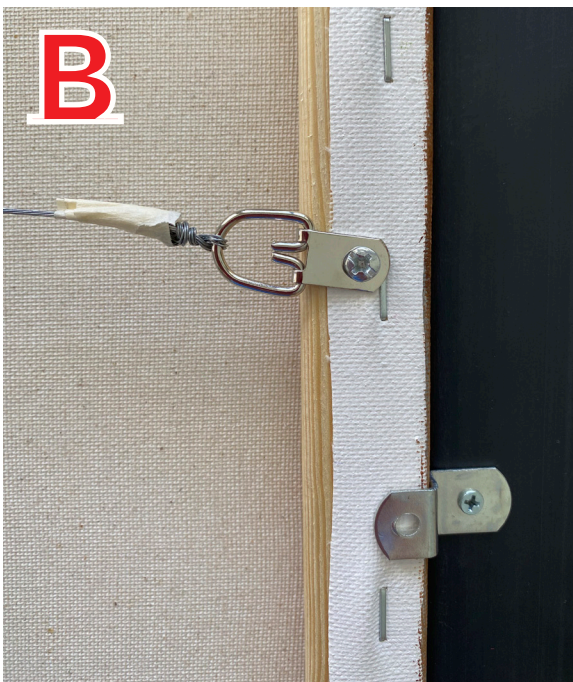


# Proper Wire Hanging

Please follow the following proper wire hanging directions when submitting artwork to a Cape Coral Art League Gallery Show. Thank you.



When wire is extended up, it has to measure **NO LESS than 3 inches from the top** at the center of the frame as shown in picture **A** at left. This is to hide the gallery wall hook from the top of the frame when the artwork is hung.



**D-Rings** are best for attaching wire to the back of the frame (screw eyes stick out and damage the walls).

Note: the ends of the picture hanging wire must be wrapped in **tape** for safety as shown in picture **B** at left.
