The Refuge is located on a subtropical barrier island of Sanibel in the Gulf of Mexico. If you haven't ever been to the Refuge, it's a very rare treat with an estimated count of over 245 different species of migratory birds that call the Refuge home. Included with birds...we will find reptiles, manatees, frogs, toads and of course alligators. The list goes on; it will be amazing to see them all in their natural habitat. Don't forget the flora. Amazing photography awaits us on all levels. The Park is considered a driving/car thru park, but there are many walking travels that await you during the session.

A picnic lunch will be provided by me, as well as water. Car entry fees will be covered as well. Be prepared to bring a towel, sunscreen, good walking shoes, a chair and of course your camera and an extra battery. I will also have umbrellas for coverage.
